**Stantek (Wenck) Report - Water Shed:** Scott reported that the Mississippi River St Cloud (MRSC) Watershed Comprehensive Watershed Management Planning Project will have a project kickoff meeting on January 31st at 5:30 PM at the Sherburne History Center. This group will include a representative from the DNR, SWCD, the county Attorney and a four member at large committee. Scott will be part of this committee representing COLA.

**Alum Feasibility Study:** Scott reported that we are unable to apply for a grant for an Alum Feasibility Study but the BLCA would be able to, we will work with the BLCA on this. The grant that is available would pay 90% of the study.

**TLID Goals for 2023 -** Stacy drafted the following goals, they were discussed - a motion was made by Mike and seconded by Diane to approved these goals for 2023. The motion was passed.

### 2023 TLID Goals

- Monitor and treat CLP, EWM, Purple Loosestrife and any other AIS as indicated by surveys and as permitted by the MN DNR.
- Record, analyze and report lake levels via Water Level Logger to provide substance for planning efforts throughout the year.
- Determine how to increase involvement in One Watershed One Plan by quarter 1 2023 to aide in future Water Stabilization efforts.
- Monitor progress of SWCD efforts to explore any available grants to fund an Alum Feasibility Study by mid-year.
