We'll put this on hold for now.

Alum Feasibility Study: We should hear more around the middle of April.

Insurance - We have two policies and pay \$1,262 per year which is right in line with similar groups. We will table this for now.

New Business:

Grants: Stacy reported that we received a grant for purple loosestrife in the amount of \$2,500 and a grant for a point intercept survey of \$2,100.
