Secretary: Nancy reported that she's been working on the list that the county sent of PID numbers and current property owners preparing for the Annual Meeting mailing. She found three properties that have two connecting parcels that

have been taxed double each year. These property owners should be only paying on one parcel. She was able to look on the county website to identify the property owners and to check that they indeed have been paying double since the TLID was formed.
