from our partner, MN Native Landscapes (<a href="www.mnlcorp.com">www.mnlcorp.com</a>). MNL can assist in plant seed selection and delivery to BLCA properties. Sample projects include planting up to 108 native plant plugs to your shoreline, enhancing an existing space with native perennial plants, or seeding a pollinator plot on your property.
