<u>Agenda</u> presented. Motion to accept by Adele Munsterman, seconded by Brad Thom. Motion passed

<u>Minutes</u> were presented for approval. Brad motioned to accept the minutes. Rosalie seconded. Motion passed

<u>New lake reps</u> Shelly made a motion to nominate Pete DeJongh as a lake rep. Pete told us about himself. Dave seconded. Motion passed. Discussion on how lake rep numbers were chosen. Think it's the size of the lake but unsure.

<u>Financials</u> were discussed. Payments made for insurance and palmer days band. Discussed the Alum feasibility grant. We have not gotten the results of the study yet. <u>Palmer day report</u> We did very well. Grossed over \$10,000. \$6066.32 profit this year as opposed to \$5400.00 last year. Got two extra boxes of burgers but sold out of everything by 5:30.

<u>Compensation of officer's</u> checks were dispersed as budgeted for.

<u>Ice days</u> Forest not here. \$715 was donated on the sponsorship form. A \$4000.00 amount was approved to give to Ice days. A check will be given to them for \$4715.00.

Everything is free at ice days but there will be a donation bucket there. This comes back to us or goes to the food shelf. Date of Ice Day will be February 8<sup>th</sup>. Question was raised about receipts for the day or just a handwritten recap.

<u>Liability insurance</u>, Cola and MN lakes and rivers invoices have discussed and shelly made a motion to pay Reuben \$300 and Marc \$200 for their work. Rosalie seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Membership.</u> There are 226 members. Brad will pick color for the new placards for members. Volunteers are needed to help with the mailing. Let Shelly know if you can help.

<u>Facebook</u> There are 4600+ members on Facebook. We have 3 admins for the Facebook page. Dave Jacobson is one and he is willing to be a backup for Brad for the newsletter. Bre handles our website and is updating things. Financials are updated quarterly on the website. Online forms and payments will continue to be on there.

<u>Directory</u> Advertising for the directory is quite reasonable. Dave reported they are compiling a list of advertisers. If you know of anyone who could advertise in the directory, please let Dave know,
