New Business:

Jonathan Morales from Moleaer presented information on nanobubbles. This is another treatment for excess phosphorous in the lake. This is due to algae build up and dying, which then decomposes in the bottom of the lake. Due to no oxygen, anaerobic bacteria grows causing blue-green algae and the odor we experience. Aeration from the nano bubbles make it an aerobic environment reducing the blue-green algae and odor. Microscopic bubbles trap the gasses and the water pumped through their system. Moleaer currently has a project on Lake Pokegama (near Pine City)
