Chair – No Report (Bob absent)

Vice Chair – Water testing – funding will be determined. Some of the results:

Phosphorous – Briggs and Rush amounts increased, Julia and Elk no significant change.

Clarity – All lakes trending better.

Chlorophyl – All lakes slightly up.

Thanks to all who do the testing on their respective lakes.

Secretary – Apologize, draft of February minutes completed, thought they were sent but apparently operator error occurred.

Treasurer – Insurance letters received, increase of \$15 beginning March 1.

Old Business: No grants for Curly Leaf control – this grant is on a lottery basis and we were not winners this year. TLID funds the control and the grant partially supplements it. TLID can receive donations from organizations.

Alum project – Dan has begun the application.

Carp removal update – There is an article in the newsletter. Estimated 18,000 carp (this is less than the Stantek report). Goal is 9,000. Majority of the carp are “old” carp. Once the ice starts going out, Carp Solutions will start studying carp movement. We need to wait for the grant to start netting. There is the question of “Would Carp solutions agree to set up prior to us receiving the grant.” The question came up thinking it would be best to trap the carp prior to spawning. The Board cannot spend above \$5,000 without approval. BLCA had fronted \$10,000 last year.

New Business: Nanobubble treatment appears more sustainable but we would like more information and need to look into possible grants. Cost of plat assessment is \$2,145 per year. Motion was made by Barb A. to pay this year and seconded by Brad. Motion carried.
