Old Business:

Curly Leaf Treatment – Maps show treated areas are clear. New areas were treated on 4.30.26. Curly Leaf appears randomly which is the reason for annual treatment. Treatments cannot exceed 15% of visible area. Rush Lake shows the most growth and we will look into a variance to cover a larger percentage.

Carp Management – Tracking sensors have been placed in creeks and are working. Most significant numbers are near the Bayou Bridge. Of the carp detected, there was a relatively equal number of carp detected from each lake. After funds are released from the Mississippi Watershed the traps will be put in place, possibly in July.

TLID Roster – Brad has 396 names with few duplicates. This needs to be cross-referenced with what the county provides.

BioBase – Brad will start testing the equipment this week. There is a limit on the data but there is plenty of data for our purpose. The focus will be on depth, bottom density, biomass (weeds).

New Business:

Wake Boarding Round Table – open discussion on best practices. Invite someone who has done studies and possibly someone from the industry. Possible date of June 20.

Lake Elevation – Mike provides monthly reports and could even supply weekly reports.

Continued to focus on – Carp, Carp fencing, Alum, Nanobubbles, Purple Loosestrife, Rush Lake treatments.
